

Law no. 47 of 2006
Regarding the approval of the
United Nations Convention against Corruption

- Having reviewed the Constitution,
- The National Assembly approved, ratified, and issued the following law:

Article 1

The United Nations Convention against Corruption, which was adopted in the General Assembly's resolution 58/4 dated 3 October 2003, has been approved. The text of the convention is attached to this law. The following shall be adhered to:

- a. Reservation to the compulsory jurisdiction of arbitration or the referral to the International Court of Justice which is stipulated in item (2) of Article 66 of the convention, and declaring the non-compliance with its provisions.
- b. Issuance of the notification referred to in item (6), paragraph (a) of Article 44 of the convention, regarding taking this convention as the legal basis for cooperation on extradition with other states and parties to this convention.
- c. Issuance of the notification referred to in item (13) of article 46 of the convention, announcing that the Ministry of Justice is the Central Authority for receiving requests of mutual legal assistance.

Article 2

Ministers shall, each with its own jurisdiction, implement this Law, and it shall be published in the Official Gazette.
